Speaker: Dianna Nausley, Relocation Assistance, Program Support, & Local Agency Program Manager – WSDOT Real Estate Services

Dianna Nausley is the Relocation Assistance, Program Support, & Local Agency Program Manager

for the Washington State Department of Transportation (WSDOT). She has more than 18 years of experience in acquisition and relocation and has been with the WSDOT Real Estate Services office for the last 21 years. She has spent the majority of her time managing the Relocation Assistance Program and more recently took on the role of the Local Agency Program Manager when Galen Wright retired in August.

Dianna is responsible for the administration of the statewide Relocation Assistance Program and the Local Agency Program for WSDOT's seven regional offices. Under her direction, the department provides training and technical guidance in relocation and acquisition matters to WSDOT staff, local public agency personnel and contract consultants, establishes policies and procedures for the statewide relocation and local agency program, and provides oversight of all relocation and local agency work with federal and state funding. She is also responsible for certifying all local agency projects that have federal financial assistance.

FHWA recently performed an evaluation of WSDOT's Local Agency Program due to ROW certification issues over the course of the last year. The main purpose of the review was to determine if WSDOT's oversight of the Local Public Agency (LPA) Right of Way (ROW) Program is ensuring LPA compliance with Federal laws and regulations. FHWA determined that WSDOT needed to make process improvements to our oversight of the LPA ROW Program to ensure that the Local Agency Coordinators are able to be proactive so project ROW can be certified and projects can proceed to construction using federal funds.

Dianna will discuss the FHWA recommendations from the Program Review and the resulting process improvements being implemented by WSDOT that will affect all Local Agency projects in Washington State that have federal funding. Local Agencies and consultants will get a sneak peak of the changes that will be rolled out by WSDOT over the next year.
